Profile Summary

Dr Abhilash Malayil was employed, since June 2010, as an Assistant Professor in History with the Department of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala before joining, in February 2020, with Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady. He completed his doctoral research at the School of Humanities and Social Sciences, Indian Institute of Technology-Mandi, Himachal Pradesh, in 2018. He became part of the European Research Council [ERC] funded research project, The New Ecology of Expressive Modes in Early-Modern South India [NEEM], headed by Prof David Shulman at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem.

Abhilash Malayil holds a Masters Degree in History from the Central University of Hyderabad and an M Phil degree in Medieval

History from the Centre for Historical Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University.

He studied economic history with Prof Rajat Datta and Dr Manu V Devadevan. His doctoral thesis, titled, 'Land Regime, Agricultural Production and Politics of Credit Money in Eighteenth-Century Malabar', has dealt with the eighteenth-century political economy of Malabar Coast, South-Western India.

He is interested in the histories of sharecropping, landed property, rural markets and now working towards completing a book manuscript on the instruments of money-credit and farm labour during the late eighteenth century. His Malayalam monograph, *Malabar Coast: A History of Land and Money*, is scheduled to be released in December 2021 from Other-Books Calicut.
